

# Supplementary Sailing Instructions

## WISC Series 13 November 2011

### to be conducted at Royal Brighton Yacht Club

All races will be governed by the current version of The RBYC Sailing Instructions Issued October 2008 except as amended below:

#### 5. Schedule of Races is replaced by:

Race Day 2 – 13 November Boat Start and finish (multiple races)

First warning 10:25

A "L" Flag will be flown from the Finish boat to indicate another race will be conducted.

#### 6. Class Flags is replaced by:

Keelboats Code Flag "V"

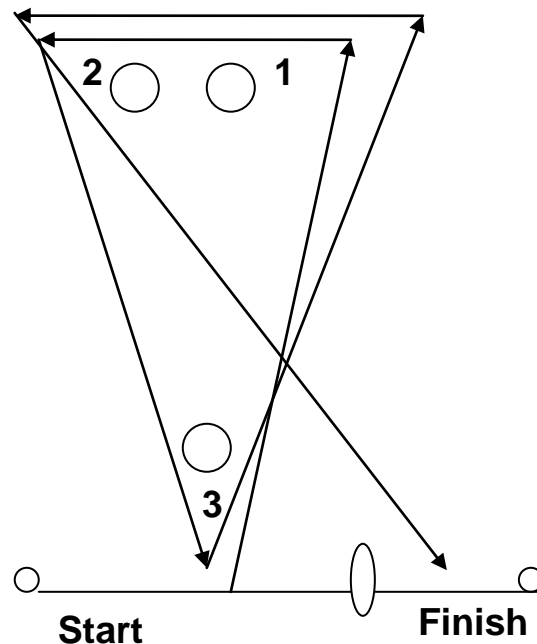
Beneteau 7.5 Code Flag "W"

#### 9. Courses is replaced by:

The diagrams below show the course configuration, including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

The race committee signal vessel may display the approximate compass bearing from the Starting Line to Mark 1.

Course 1 Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – 1 – 2 – Finish



**10. Marks is replaced by:**

Mark 1 will be a Pink Inflatable buoy

Marks 2 and 3 will be orange inflatable buoys

New marks, as provided in instruction 15, will be a yellow inflatable buoys replacing Mark 3 and a pink inflatable buoy with a black band replacing Mark 1.

The starting mark will be an inflatable yellow buoy.

The finish mark will be an inflatable yellow buoy

**13. Start is replaced by:**

Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26

a) Between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Committee Vessel at the starboard end and the port-end starting mark.

b) A crowding mark carrying Code Flag 'O' may be laid near the Committee Vessel, but not necessarily on the starting line. When laid, this mark shall be considered an extension of the Committee Vessel.

A boat starting later than 5 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS without a hearing. This changes RRS A4.

**16. Finish is replaced by:**

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Committee Vessel at the starboard end and the port-end finishing mark.

**18. Time Limits is replaced by:**

The time limit shall be 1 1/2 hours. Any boat that has not finished within the time limit expires will be scored DNF.
